- In 2006 The World Fighting Championships held its first event at the Ala Carte Pavilion which is a 1,200 seat arena. Avg ticket price—\$35.00
- In 2007 at the WFC's fourth event "Cage Wars" the organization had to move to

the Florida State Fairgrounds Arena which seats 7,000. Avg ticket price—\$45.00

- In 2008 the WFC held its 6th event "Battle in the Bay" at the University of South Florida's Sun Dome which is a 8,000 seat Arena. Avg ticket price—\$60.00
